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EXIT WESTGATE PARK
Take same bike path back along Todd Road to The Boulevard

ENTER GARDEN CITY
Cross The Boulevard at the pedestrian crossing into Batman Rd
Refreshments available at Centre Avenue Shops

HISTORIC HOUSING ESTATES
Bank Houses on left
Early Commission houses on right

GARDEN CITY RESERVE
Enter the Reserve via the path from Beacon Rd
Rear Beacon well worth a detour
Dogs and kids on the loose!
Exit the Reserve through the Car Park and proceed to Swallow St

GRAHAM ST OVERPASS
Cross the Light Rail at the traffic lights
Trams both directions!
Under the Overpass see the spectacular graffiti display and the custom-built ramps and banks for skateboarding
Skateboarders!

LIARDET STREET
Travel along Stokes St, turning left at Liardet St
Nott Street Corner
Liardet Community Centre
Bay St Corner
Olive's Corner 'Pocket Park'

LAGOON RESERVE
Take Esplanade West along the perimeter of Lagoon Reserve
Bike-riding not permitted on Reserve
Graham St Corner
Historic Graham Hotel (c1870)

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GASWORKS ARTS PARK
Galleries, Theatres, Cafe & Bike Racks!

7 ENTER WESTGATE PARK
via the path opposite Cook St

At the bridge over the path read about the biodiversity of the park

Take the path between the lakes down to the spot marked 'Lookout', where there are spectacular views of the city

Cross the second bridge and follow the path around the Freshwater Lake

SANDRIDGE BEACH
Take the Bike Path along the promenade and dunes above the beach
The rocky walls jutting into the sea are called 'groynes'.
Follow the Bike Path as it turns up Todd Rd

PRINCES PIER
Consider a detour from the Bike Path to explore the pier
No longer a working pier, it is now a wide open recreational space, with trees, artworks, touch-screens, and binocular stations for observing ships

THE BEACONS
There are two beacons, the Front Beacon in the sea, the Rear Beacon inland
A copper display, facing the Front Beacon, tells the story of the two lights
Walkers and joggers on shared path
